

Remarks On Board Ship Dartmouth Bound  
Wednesday 23 August

24 hours all sail out steering to the South a sundown put her  
under South's Reef Top Sails course South Middle part wind E & E  
later all sail out with breaking out for chocks and repairing Starboard Boat  
Long by Chron 176° 02 West Lat 37° 26 South  
Thursday 24 August

24 hours Cloudy with fair breeze from the S.E. course South all  
sail out Middle and later part cloudy weather strong breeze struck a  
poop fire saw a sulphur bottom and plenty of porpoises  
Friday 25th

24 hours Cloudy strong breeze course South a sundown under South's Reef on our course  
Middle part the same later part wind freshened finished the Starboard  
Boat  
Saturday 26th

24 hours took in fore top sail and fore sail luffed to east chock Reep Main  
top sail blowing a gale set the spencers Middle part wind hauled to the  
S.W. later moderated set the fore top sail & fore sail  
Long by Chron 175° 00 West Lat by Bar 32° 10 S  
Sunday 27th

24 hours Squally winds W.S.W heading S.W. a sundown took in  
sail Middle part strong winds squally later part made sail a 10 O'clock  
put away for Matita made all sail course East  
Long 174° 46 West Lat by Bar 31° 33 S  
Monday 28th

24 hours More clear course East winds moderate standing half masts Middle part  
light winds later the same saw a ship steering to the S.W. took in  
poop fire Blubber turned up 3 gallons we had a few squalls rain  
Long by Chron 173° 24 West Lat by Bar 31° 46 South

to the South Wright Whaling West Bound to Matita  
Tuesday 25th August

24 hours fine breeze from the S.W. course East all sail out  
but the Spanker Middle part cloudy later part rainy all sail out  
No shot this day  
Wednesday 29th

24 hours under South's Reef blowing fresh sail in night  
winds S by E Middle part heavy squalls took in all sail lay under  
bars fell winds West w any irregular sea at daylight more moderate  
made all sail course S.E.  
Long by Luner 167° 50 West by Bar 167° 20 W Lat 32° 01 South  
Thursday 30th

24 hours fine weather all sail out course S.E. winds S.W. Middle part  
strong breeze later squally with heavy rain thunder & lightning cleared  
up fore & main top sails took in main & fore sail 9:00 - course S.E.  
Long by Chron 164° 12 West Lat 30° 30 South  
Friday 31st

24 hours cleared off set the fore sail fore top sail winds S.W. with a few squalls of  
rain Middle part strong winds and the later part the same  
Long by Chron 161° 39 West Lat by Bar 29° 32 S  
Saturday 1 September

24 hours Strong winds and a heavy sea course S.E. under South's Reef  
winds West Middle part more moderate all sail out later light winds  
Long by Chron 159° 57 West Lat by Bar 27° 27 South  
Sunday 2 September

24 hours light winds from the S.W. course S.E. by S 1 point and 1/2  
variation Middle part cloudy later part the same  
all sail out  
Long by Chron 158° 16 West Lat 26° 33 S on  
Matita bearing S.E. by E  
about 720 miles
