

Remarks On Board Ship Dartmouth
Friday 23 November

First part of these 24 hours heavy swell winds at N.W. came S.E. in company with the R. H. & sundown took in sail. Middle part strong breezes from the N.W. & latter part the same took in fore & main sail & fore sail to the South 2 ships in sight. Lat by Obs 38° 44'

Saturday 24th Nov

First part of these 24 hours strong winds from the N.W. laying too to the South under short sail. Middle part more ship to the N.W. winds. South latter part more moderate made sail. Steering to the West

Long by Lunar 170° 26' by Chron 171° 06' W Lat 38° 22' S

Sunday 25th Nov

1. M. First part of these 24 hours fine ship. Remarks 2100 P.M. & sundown took in sail to the North. Middle part fine. Latter part the same all sail out to the S.E. Long by Chron 171° 10' W Lat 38° 39' South

Monday 26th

First part of these 24 hours fine saw 2 ships, 1 Boiling all steering to the South & night took in sail in company with the Hercules to the S.E. Middle part fine & daylight made sail caught 2 porpoises steering S by W spoke the same ship of sundown Capt Richards goods. W. 9. strong winds from the N.E. & S.E.

Long by Chron 170° 54' Lat 38° 40' S

Tuesday 27th Nov

First part of these 24 hours rugged steering S by W & sundown took in sail to the N.W. saw 1 night whale. Middle and latter parts thick rain. Lat by Obs 38° 48'

Wednesday 28th

First part of these 24 hours thick foggy weather under short sail to the West winds at N.W. to S.E. Middle part foggy with rain. Latter part lighted up a little saw a whale. Latter 2 boats and struck to the Starboard Boat and then lowered the Starboard Boat turned him up both him alongside and commenced cutting saw a whale. Latter without success

Thursday 29th November

First part of these 24 hours finished cutting thick foggy weather more ship to the N.E. & S.E. - winds at N.W. took in fore sail. Middle part thick and rainy & daylight cleared a little saw a whale going quick to the South. Latter without success. Long by Chron 171° 56' W Lat by Obs 40° 23'

Friday 30th November

First part of these 24 hours Boiling spoke the ship of Starboard Boat Capt Brock 3100 W. Whale & lowered for whale struck to the Starboard Boat and got stove. Capt took the line most of windward and came on thick and cut. Middle and latter parts employed in Boiling could down latter part. Long by Chron 171° 23' West Lat by Obs 40° 09' S

Saturday 1st December

First part of these 24 hours fine 4 ship in sight mended 1 Boat in company with the Navy saw whale going South quick. Latter without success & night took in sail to the S.W. winds S.E. Middle part fine & daylight strong winds from the S.W. room. Ship to the S.E. under short sail employed in steering down in fore hole 3800

Long by Chron 171° 18' West Lat by Obs 39° 56'

Sunday 2nd December

First part of these 24 hours strong winds spoke ship Francis Henrietta of Starboard Boat 19 months out 800 tons. Spoke 1600 tons. Night & sundown cleared the decks and took in fore sail. Latter part main sail to the S.E. Middle part strong & daylight set the fore sail left hoist at 6

Long by Chron 171° 34' West Lat by Obs 39° 35' S

Monday 3rd Dec

First part of these 24 hours strong winds from the S.E. steering S by E. saw nothing & sundown here too to the East. Middle part moderate down & daylight made all sail to the East fine weather wind. South saw nothing with remarking
