

Remarks on Board Ship Eastmarch

Wednesday 11th September

Strong winds blowing S.E. spoke ship of Sagharboon cutting a storm which a night took in sail to the S.E. Middle and latter part a gale

Thursday 12th

First part of these 24 hours a gale from the S.E. under spinnaker and main top sail 2 sail in sight blowing to the S.E. Middle and latter part a gale and raining

Friday 13th

First part of these 24 hours a gale thick and raining Middle part the same latter wind fell off but rainy the S.E. in sight

Saturday 14th

First part of these 24 hours light winds and a heavy swell wind S.W. 2 sail in sight Middle part same latter part calm and clear 2 sail in sight

Long by Lunar $174^{\circ} 25'$ West by the $17^{\circ} 00'$ Lat $33^{\circ} 43'$ S

Sunday 15th

First part of these 24 hours light airs and calm without fore & aftmost sail and top sail Middle part calm latter part light wind from the W. S.W. course S.W. by E

Long by Lunar $173^{\circ} 49'$ by the $174^{\circ} 12'$ West Lat by the $33^{\circ} 30'$

Monday 16th September

First part of these 24 hours light wind all sail out to the S.E. nothing in sight Middle and latter part a gale blowing to the East

Lat $32^{\circ} 47'$

Tuesday 17th

First part the same Middle part same latter heavy storm Lat $32^{\circ} 08'$

Wednesday 18th

First part strong North wind all sail out to the East Middle part same latter part more moderate still fore and main top sail by the wind to the S.E. long by the $173^{\circ} 09'$ Lat $31^{\circ} 13'$ South

Thursday 19th September

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from the S.E. by the wind to the S.W. a night took in sail spoke Mainmast Sagharboon Middle part the same latter part under double Reef to the North spoke ship Parashat New Zealand

Friday 20th

First part of these 24 hours strong winds from the S.E. a sun down took in sail to the S.E. Middle and latter part same blowing too to the S.E.

Long by the $174^{\circ} 14'$ West Lat $30^{\circ} 52'$

Saturday 21st

First part of these 24 hours strong winds from the S.E. 1 sail in sight Middle and latter part the same

Lat $31^{\circ} 29'$ South

Sunday 22nd

First part of these 24 hours strong winds set the same sail to the S.E. 2 ships in sight a sun down took in fore sail wind S.E. Middle and latter part moderate made sail to the South

Long by the $174^{\circ} 35'$ West Lat by the $32^{\circ} 21'$

Monday 23rd

First part of these 24 hours good weather strong to the S.W. winds S.W. by E a sun down took in sail 1 ship in sight Middle and latter part heavy under double Reef

Long by the $174^{\circ} 45'$ West Lat $32^{\circ} 28'$

Tuesday 24th

First part of these 24 hours no alterations in the weather a sun down took in sail and S.W. by E 2 sail in sight Middle part wind hauled to the S.W. at daylight part then to S.E. Thick and rainy & blowing heavy

Lat $32^{\circ} 19'$ S

Wednesday 25th

First part of these 24 hours course S.E. by S wind S with a heavy sea thick weather a sun down took in fore sail blowing too to the S.W. under double Reef Main top sail a daylight set fore sail fore top sail main top sail course S.E. by E

Long by the $175^{\circ} 15'$ West Lat by the $31^{\circ} 08'$
