

Remarks On Board Ship: Dartmouth
Thursday 18th Oct

These 24 hours begins with strong wind from the S.W. & E. laying to the North under short sail at sundown in sail several ships in sight Middle and latter strong winds laying to

Friday 19th

First part of this day strong winds at sundown set some sail to the S.W. & E. & sail in sight Middle part. Calm latter rain fell sail lowered for Blackfish and got 4 or 5 fish in sight 1 Whaler

Long by Bar 174° 34' West 2 Lat by Bar 51° 28'

Saturday 12th

First part light airs from the East and rainy. After 10 o'clock S.W. & E. at sundown shortened sail Middle part rainy and cloudy till daylight. Made sail raised a Whaler. Whaler hauled without success at 10 lowered without success long 174° 49' W Lat 51° 32' S

Sunday 13th Oct

First part of these 24 hours fine weather steering to the S.W. & E. wind S.E. at sundown took in sail Middle and latter strong winds from the S.E.

Monday 14th Oct

First of these 24 hours fine weather spoke Panama Sagharboun 1200. At some spoke at sundown lay under short sail to the S.W. Middle part light airs latter part calm

Long by Bar 174° 27' by Bar 174° 48' W Lat 50° 54'

Tuesday 15th

First part of these 24 hours Calm lowered and took a sunfish at sundown took in sail Middle part Calm latter part took 4 Blackfish and cut them in

Long by Bar 174° 42' W Lat by Bar 50° 49'

Wednesday 16th Oct

First part of these 24 hours light airs from S.W. & E. laying South at 6 lowered for a pod of long Whales going gibber without success took in sail to the North Middle part same latter part same. Braces at 11 saw a small Whaler

First part of these 24 hours lowered for W. Whaler without success at 2 lowered again and struck the Starboard Boat and took him alongside and cut him in finished at sundown took in sail at 2 o'clock in sight Middle part strong winds latter part same at 3 lowered for Whaler struck to the Starboard Boat at 10 took him alongside Lat by Bar 32° 25'

Friday 19th

First part of these 24 hours commenced cutting Whales at 6 commenced Whaling laying to the East Middle part same latter part was hit to the S.W. & sail in sight Whaling

Long by Bar 175° 09' West Lat by Bar 32° 35' South

Saturday 19th

First part of these 24 hours fine with strong winds from the North at 5 were hit to the East under short sail Middle and latter Whaling blowing strong breaking out after 10 o'clock

Sunday 20th

First part strong winds from the North laying West heavy sea strong down at 9 finished Whaling Middle part raged with heavy to the West latter part strong down

Long by Bar 175° 00' West Lat 33° 15'

Monday 21st

First part of these 24 hours raged steering S.W. & E. at 5 finished steering down at 10 o'clock spoke Ship spoke Williams. Stronington 16 White out 400 400 down took in sail to the west wind spoke W. Middle part same latter part made sail course of E by S spoke American Sagharboun

Long by Bar 174° 30' W Tuesday 22nd Oct Lat 32° 33'

First part of these 24 hours strong winds course at 6 by S all sail out at sundown took in sail to the South Middle part same latter course East

Long by Bar 173° 39' W Lat 32° 38' S

Wednesday 23rd

First part strong wind course at 6 at 6 at sundown took in sail to the North Middle and latter part more moderate strong South
