

Remarks On Board Ship Dartmouth Co
Thursday 14th January 1840

First part more clear but cloudy
wind hauled to the West, all sail out Middle and latter parts
Clear light wind from N.W. under East
Long by Chr 160° 26' W Lat 45° 61'

Wednesday 15th

First part of them 24 hours fair light
wind came E by S all sail out Middle and latter light wind all
staying sails on Main Mast North side wind West
Long by Chr 158° 16' W Lat 44° 07' 28"

Thursday 16th

First part good wind from N.W.
every out course E by S middle and latter part light and calm
Long by Chr 155° 38' W Lat 44° 33'

Friday 17th

First part Calm plenty seen
saw 1 bright whale a sundown light wind from the N.W.
Middle and latter parts strong wind from the west took in spars
and lashed them and changed the day Long by Chr 149° 38' W Lat 46° 07'

Saturday 18th

First part of them 24 hours strong
winds Middle and latter parts same course E by N wind N.W. N
Long by Chr 144° 58' West Lat 46° 36'

Sunday 19th

same as bright whale First part the same all prudent sail out
Middle part same latter part took in N.W. most stony sail and top of S. sail
and top of S. sail came E by wind North Long 161° 00' W Lat 48° 30'

Monday 20th

First part cloudy strong wind no alteration
Middle and latter parts strong wind from N.W. under E top course East
of E thick weather

Tuesday 21st

First part of them 24 hours thick
under E top course E by N Middle part thick and rain passed 13k
Harvest of Bridgeport 1900 lbs at daylight wind hauled to the N.W.
under all sail came E by N the 13k taken

Long by Chr 132° 37' West Lat 47° 08'

Over Homeward Bound Passage

Wednesday 22nd

First part heavy wind gave her
some course E by N Middle and latter parts same
Long by Chr 129° 04' West Lat 46° 57'

Thursday 23rd

First part strong wind from the
N.W. under E by N, all sail out Middle and latter parts course
E by N Long by Chr 125° 30' West Lat 46° 00'

Friday 24th

First part no alteration
Middle parts and latter much the same clear all the time
Long by Chr 121° 46' W Lat 45° 45'

Saturday 25th

First part of them 24 hours cloudy
course East all sail out under N.W. Middle and latter parts light wind
from the West Chronometer Run Down set her going again
Long by Chr 119° 46' West of Gull's Lat 46° 07'

Sunday 26th

First part of them 24 hours fair
weather light wind from the West all sail out Middle part overcast
latter part raining wind N.W. under E top course East
Long by Chr 117° 40' Monday 27th Lat 46° 50'

Monday 27th

First part of them 24 hours thick
and rainy almost calm saw Blackfish going South Middle part heavy
wind from the West a dry light strong wind from the South took in
N.W. Long by Chr 115° 04' West Lat 47° 04'

Tuesday 28th

First part strong wind under top sails
course East wind N.W. Middle and latter part the same all sail out
Long by the mean of 4 chronos 111° 18' West Long by Chr at the same time
110° 52' West a diff of 34 miles Long by Chr afternoon corrected by chronos
110° 29' West Lat 47° 30' Note of Chr corrects 5' 40"

Wednesday 29th

First part heavy swell all sail out course
East Middle part Calm latter part much the same all sail out
Long by chronos 107° 37' West Lat 47° 41' South
Long by Chr 107° 29'
