Saturday 29th Feb

First part light air and
calm, repairing sails Middle and latter parts calm
Long 32° 15' W Lat 34° 40'

Sunday 1st March

First and middle parts calm
the China 5 miles to the S.E. and daylight from Brecon from
the S.E. & all sail out toward Ship to the S.W. the China
out of sight & came in sight again
Long by Chron 31° 41' West Lat 34° 38'

Monday 2nd March

First part of the 24 hours
calm and light air from the North by the Middle and latter parts
fair all hands employed in Ship Duty
Long by Chron 30° 50' West Lat 34° 20'

Tuesday 3rd March

First part of the 24 hours
fair all hands employed in fitting rigging and repairing
some top sail in company with the China
Long by Chron 28° 50' West Lat 33° 38'

Wednesday 4th

First part of the 24 hours
fair strong wind from the S.W. by the S.E. by E
all sail out Middle parts same latter parts strong wind
took in top gallant sails and 2 sheets top sail with China
Long by Chron 26° 34' West Lat 32° 29'

Thursday 5th

First part of the 24 hours
under Main Sailing to the S.E. wind at the Middle and latter
parts under 4th sheet top sails to the S.E.
Long by Chron 24° 43' W Lat 31° 35'

Friday 6th

First part strong wind from
the S.W. by the S.E. Middle and latter cloudy and rainy
sailing along to the S.E. & the China out of sight
Lat 31° 30'

Bound to New Bedford

Saturday 17th March

First part of these 24 hours
wind S by W all sail out to the S.E. by E a sunny cloudy and
rainy wind from the West cross S. Middle and latter parts
changeable wind and rainy weather the China here in sight

Sunday 8th March No. Attacker No. Lat

First part of these 24 hours rainy
wind S by W. Sailing to the S.E. Top 3 sails in Middle parts
heavy squalls from the S.W. and heavy rains both calm and cloudy
Long by Chron 23° 44' W Lat 29° 50'

Monday 9th

calm Middle parts same latter parts light wind from S.E. &
all sail out Long by Chron 24° 00' W Lat 29° 06'

we have not seen for weeks China out of sight
