Ship Lamer in sight Lat. 9. 40. S

Sunday May 27th fine weather and light breeze
gaming with ship Lamer Lat. 9. 44. South
Long 66. 00. East

Monday May 28th light breeze and fine weather
employed in breaking out water later fine weather
employed in cleaning iron work at sunset on the north
end of the bank in 18 fathoms water caught about
28 fish Lat. 9. 44. South
Long 66. 18. East

Tuesday May 29th light breeze and fine weather
employed in cleaning iron work at sunset took in
sail Lamer in sight Lat. 9. 40. South
Long 66. 38. East

Wednesday May 30th light breeze and fine weather
employed in coal boring iron work later the same
with fine weather from ship Lamer

Thursday May 31st the same with light breeze and
fine weather employed in mending main top sail
saw a school of 10 fish at sunset bent the
main top sail and took in sail there the dead got
24 fathoms water Lat. 10. 00. South
Long 66. 40. East

Friday May 31st Strong breeze and squally weather
employed in breaking out mear later strong
breeze at sunset took in sail Lat. 9. 40. S
Long 66. 08. E

Saturday June 1st light breeze and fine weather
saw ship steering to the North later spoke bank
Atlantic Cap. King 1180 barrels Whale oil Part season
1900 barrels all told spoke ship Lamer
Lat. 9. 40. S
Long 66. 11. E

Sunday June 2nd Commenced with Strong breeze and
squally weather Ship Lamer and Atlantic in sight
Lat. 10. 10. S
Long 66. 10. E

Monday June 3rd Strong breeze and fine weather
Ship Lamer and Atlantic in sight later saw Lamer
bank a whale alongside Lat. 10. 08. S
Long 66. 20. E

Tuesday June 4th Strong breeze and clear weather
saw ship Lamer cutting Lat. 9. 38. S
Long 66. 29. E

Wednesday June 5th light breeze and fine weather
employed in the rigging later the same with
fine weather spoke bank Atlantic sunset took in
sail Lat. 10. 11. S
Long 66. 19. E

Thursday June 6th Commenced with light breeze and
fine weather at 9. raised whaly lowered and got line
got them along side at 2 hooked down and commenced
to cut at 10 finished cutting Lat. 10. 30
Long 66. 30

Friday June 7th cleared up decks and commenced to
haul back Atlantic in sight cutting

Saturday light breeze with rain squally employed
in coiling later the same with light breeze
finished coiling at 10 and washed of decks

Sunday Strong breeze and squally weather gaming
with ship Lamer Lat. 10. 02
Long 66. 44

Monday June 10th Strong breeze ship Lamer in
sight stowing down oil later strong breeze employed
in cooping oil Lat. 9. 58. S
Long 66. 08. E
