

Remarks On Board Bark. Castimena 1867

Sunday July 17th Strong breeze from the south-east
heading to the south under single reefed topsails
Lat 17° 41' S. Long 58° 47' E
Monday July 18th more moderate heading to the south
with all sail out Lat 17° 34' S. Long 59° 41' E

Tuesday July 19th commences with light breeze from
the south-east at 4 A.M. wind hauls more to the
south soon ship to the east daylight said 4th
Coast distance 60 miles

Wednesday July 20th fresh breeze from the south
heading to the east after employed in mending
foretop sail at 4 squally with water sheet's sunset
under reefed the topsails Lat 17° 30' S. Long 59° 20' E

Thursday July 21st fresh breeze from the south
day and evening strong breeze bearing east
at 10 miles about 20 miles employed in mending
foretop sail sunset more ship to the south
Lat 17° 10' S. Long 58° 10' E

Friday July 22nd light breeze and fine weather
day and night sound island bearing south by east 20 miles
distance men employed in the rigging Lat 17° 58' S. Long 58° 12' E

Saturday July 23rd light breeze from the east
heading to the south afternoon wet hazy and squally
ship 30 spoke Ring Wild Wave of Hobart in ground
to maintain Lat 20° 10' S. Long 58° 40' E

Sunday July 24th commences with a light breeze
from the south-east at daylight ship away calm at
4 light breeze from the south heading to the east
Lat 20° 22' S. Long 59° 10' E

Monday July 25th Commences with light breeze from
the south heading east with all sail out afternoon wind
increasing took in the light sails Lat 20° 10' S. Long 60° 21' E

Tuesday July 26th Strong breeze from the south daylight
more moderate at main top sail and flying gill
at 4 P.M. raised Rodriguez Island bearing east 20 miles
distance Lat 19° 54' S. Long 62° 54' E

Wednesday July 27th Commences with light breeze
from the south daylight land bearing east at 2 P.M.
went ashore with Capt. Phinney sunset came aboard Capt
at 10 there

Thursday July 28th fine weather at 11 went ashore for
the Captain got aboard at sunset and left way west

Friday July 29th Strong breeze heading to the south
and ship's sunset took in sail out more ship
Lat 19° 45' S. Long 62° 38' E

Saturday July 30th Strong breeze and squally weather
forenoon employed in mending foretop sail afternoon wet
hazy and washed ship Lat 19° 40' S. Long 62° 20' E

Sunday July 31st light breeze and fine weather

Monday July 29th light breeze and fine weather
employed in mending foretop sail and did correct
took in sail Lat 19° 40' S. Long 62° 32' E

Tuesday July 30th Commences with fine weather
forenoon employed in mending foretop sail P.M.
employed in the rigging sunset took in sail
Lat 19° 46' S. Long 62° 26' E

Wednesday July 31st Commences with strong breeze
and squally weather daylight more moderate turned
the reef's later the same sunset more moderate took in sail
