Aug 1<sup>st</sup> Light breeze and fine weather employed in mending main topsail latter part the same sunset took in sail Lat 18 48 S Long 62 40 E

Friday Aug 2<sup>nd</sup> Commenced with light breeze and fine weather men employed in the rigging Sunset took in sail Lat 18 52 S Long 62 44 E

Saturday Aug 3<sup>rd</sup> Fresh breeze and fine weather Afternoon wet hole and washed ship sunset took in sail Lat 26 00 S Long 62 56 E

Sunday Aug 4<sup>th</sup> fine weather at 9 o'clock sailed for Bahia de Todos Santos east. afternoon fine weather sunset took in sail Land bearing east dist 24 miles

Monday Aug 5<sup>th</sup> Commenced with fresh breeze from the south east at 10 o'clock Land bearing east dist 20 miles at seven o'clock went west then sailed to the south west where ship to the east sunset took in sail

Tuesday Aug 6<sup>th</sup> Strong breeze working up to the land to go in to anchor have cruised here two weeks have not seen anything every one is getting down hearted sunset Land bearing east south east dist 10 miles

Wednesday Aug 7<sup>th</sup> Strong breeze from the south east Land bearing south east strong current running to the westward

Thursday Aug 8<sup>th</sup> wind increasing double reefed the topsails sunset set Land bearing S. E. dist 20 miles

Friday Aug 9<sup>th</sup> Breeze strong going off and on in the south west. Topails

Saturday Aug 10<sup>th</sup> more moderate in sails and stood in at ten o'clock strong again reefed down sunset Land bearing east dist 14 miles

Sunday Aug 11<sup>th</sup> Strong trade wind in up under down reefed to main sunset Land bearing east dist 10 miles

Monday Aug 12<sup>th</sup> Strong breeze blowing to the south at four o'clock ship to the east employed in breaking out meat and water after noon Strong breeze sunset Land bearing south dist 15 miles

Tuesday Aug 13<sup>th</sup> Strong breeze daylight of the harbor at ten o'clock a pilot and came to anchor and commenced to work ship sunset weather more moderate

Wednesday Aug 14<sup>th</sup> employed in getting well washing ship taking the rigging &c weather squally No other packet in sight at sunset standing in

Thursday Aug 15<sup>th</sup> weather squally schooner came in from Bahia de Todos Santos meaning afternoon sailing

Friday Aug 16<sup>th</sup> employed in painting ship weather good

Saturday Aug 17<sup>th</sup> employed in painting ship &c at noon second mate went on a gunning and in the evening he is back to morning with sun & weather fine

Sunday Aug 18<sup>th</sup> fine weather wind at 10 o'clock all hands went ashore on a run sunset came aboard and second mate from gunning

Monday Aug 19<sup>th</sup> employed in painting ship and stowing away water Sunset fine weather
