

Cyber Maritime Cruising Oct. 1867.

Saturday Sept 28th light breeze and fine weather heading to the south later fine weather heading east sunset took in the light sails heading to the south

Sunday Sept 29th fine weather and light breeze from the southeast Lat 20.58. S Long 58.30. East

Monday Sept 30th fine weather and light breeze from the south employed in breaking out meat and water sunset took in the light sails heading E. of E Lat 20.30. Long 58.11. E

Tuesday Oct 1st fine weather employed in breaking out ground forward sunset took in sail

Wednesday Oct 2nd fresh breeze and fine weather heading to the east Lat 19.50. S Long 60.11. E

Thursday Oct 3rd strong breeze heading to the south under south sheet spruce at 4 P.M. raised spruce whales lowered the boats and got three small ones got them along side at sunset Lat 19.10. S Long 60.20. S

Friday Oct 4th daylight called all hands and commenced to cut at 2 P.M. finished cutting and commenced to hoist sun set strong breeze and fine weather Lat 19.03. S Long 60.00. East

Saturday Oct 5th light breeze and fine weather employed in boiling later fine weather spoke bark E. Course 14 months out 1100 lbs

Sunday Oct 6th fine weather 11. a.m. finished boiling and washed off decks Lat 18.18. S Long 59.48. East

Monday Oct 7th light breeze and fine weather employed in stowing down oil at two finished and washed off decks sunset took in the light sails heading to the south

Tuesday Oct 8th light breeze and fine weather heading to the south noon wore ship to the east sunset took in sail Lat 18.40. S Long 59.54

Wednesday Oct 9th light breeze and fine weather heading to the east men employed in making spun yarn sunset took in sail Lat 19.55. S Long 60.15. East

Thursday Oct 10th Commenced with strong breeze from the southeast night at 10 raised spruce whales got one small one took him along side at noon got dinner and commenced to cut fine wood at three and started the work Lat 19.07. S Long 60.39. East

Friday Oct 11. Strong breeze employed in boiling later the same at 4 P.M. finished boiling and washed off decks 28 barrels turned up Lat 18.25. S Long 60.44. East

Saturday Oct 12th light breeze and fine weather heading to the east sunset wore ship to the south and took in sail Lat 18.10. S Long 60.20. East

Sunday Oct 13th fine weather and light breeze from the south saw sail heading to the east sunset took in sail Lat 18.25. S Long 60.40

Monday Oct 14 fine weather employed in stowing down oil breaking out water and meat afternoon spoke bark China and Atlantic China had taken 100 barrels the last six weeks here Atlantic eight days from Mauritius Lat 18.11. S
