Saturday August 5 1876

Came with fresh Easterly gales
Bk under Double head topsails
Steam & wind veered to S.W.
at Sunset saw a large sperm
Whale going S to Lake 1. Lower
middle and latter part fine weather
nothing in sight

Came with moderate N.W. winds
and veered to W Coarse & Middle
and latter part much the same
nothing in sight

various jobs about ship

Commenced with light & variable
winds Coarse & at sunset Shalena
Sail watch jip in various jobs
about ship Middle and latter part
fine weather light westerly cur
Coarse S & nothing in sight

Thursday 10

Came with light air and
calms jip in various jobs
about ship at 6 P.M. lowered 4
Boats to practice crews Middle
and latter part light air and calms

Friday 11

Came with light air and calms
Coarse & all sail out Middle and
latter part light air and calms
Saw groups and Porpoise

Came with light N.W. winds

him in sent water below Middle
