Have a pleasant day. working up for Fayal
at 9 A. M. Cap Vincent went in the Starboard
Boat an shor Mr Stewart our first Officer
came bak an Bord again Cap Vincent
stept an shor over Night saw one Shear
and severall Vessels at Anchor in Fayal
Harbor. employet, working Ship.

Thursday September 28th

Came with strong Gales and heavy Sea running
Ship under close Reef Topsail heading W. by N.
Fayal 15 Mile distant bearing by compass N.
Capt Vincent is an shor

Friday 29th
Have strong breezes in the vornoun
working up for Fayal towards night most
calm distant from Fayal 10 mile

Saturday 30th
Com with strong Gales and Regen from
the S. W. Ship under close Main Topsail
towards noon the Wind shifted to the N.
at night Fayal bearing N. E. distant 20 mile

Sunday October 1st
Have a strong Breeze steering for Fayal
have a pleasant day at 1 P. M. returned our
first Officer wand bak an shor again
silk employet working ship

Monday 2nd
Com with pleasant Weather. Cap Vincent
dispargeth Mr Stewart our first Officer
silk to day. received our Potatoes and
Onions sony severall other Recruits to day
in the Afternoon Capt Vincent came
on Board and we left Fayal bound to
the S. 9 Whalers in port.

Tuesday 3rd
Have light Wind saw some Vessels
Ship steering along the shore Land distant 10 mile
employet breakingout for Water and Provision
and taking bak of our Recruits
