16th

Came with light Wind and Calms take
the Water bark on Shore and Sp. Vincent
went on shore and brought some Potatoes on
Board. Tristan 5 Miles Distans seen an and of
Weather to take the Water on board

Have mostly Calms the Wind very Light
from the N. sent one Boat fishing one Sail
in sight at night the Boat came back with
great many Fish

Thursday January 18th

Have strong Breezes from the N. with some
Rain as chance to send my Boats after Water
Tristan Distans 10 Miles employed so far Fish.

Friday 19th Come pleasant and calm at Daylight 3 Boats
Went on Shore after the Raft of Water brought
the Water on Board next morning Tristan 6 Miles off

Saturday 20th

Have pleasant the first part and strong
the later part of Day got one Boat load of Potatoes
from Shore of the Day Spoke Bark Sea Ranger
Capt Flanders 6 1/2 Months out 832 Barrels of Oil
Tristan Bearing S. Distans 20 Miles Wind from
the W.

Sunday 21st

Came a pleasant Day Gamet with Bark
Sea Ranger 6 1/2 Months out 830 Barrels of Oil also
Ship California 2 Months out 1700 Sperm Oil
Tristan in sight

Monday 22nd

Came a pleasant the latter part Rain
and Squally sent the Boats on Shore
after Potatoes Wood and Meat also gamet
with Bark Sea Ranger towards Night left
Tristan bound S.

Tuesday 23rd

Have a pleasant Day sometime Fogg Wind
from the N.W. bound to the S. after Night
Whales nothing in sight
