

B. Deadmona Bound to St Helena

April 16th

Pleasant - with fresh breeze from S.E. steering W. in company with the frigate at sunset - Capt. Peck sent on board of and I fast fresh breeze at daylight sighted the land near W. 1/2 N.

April 17th

Pleasant - weather and fresh breeze from S.E. steering in for the land. Departed off anchor at 8.30 a.m. left go. Hancock employed setting up masts and washing ship at side.

April 18th

S. W. Pleasant - weather at daylight - collected all hands and commenced to break out oil to ship on board the George and Susan sent on board 14 barrels at 1.30 broke off work.

April 19th

Boating weather and sunshine collect all hands at daylight and commenced to break out oil and cooper and employed in painting out side at 1.30 broke off work. Capt. Meyer has 3 bbls Beef & 4 gallons paint - oil.

April 20th

Pleasant - weather with moderate breeze at daylight called all hands commenced to discharge oil on board of and Susan employed in setting up shooks and painting ship out side, so ends put on board 8 barrels of whale bone.

April 21st

Pleasant - weather called all hands at daylight - commenced work employed in discharging oil and putting up shooks put on board of Briggs station of background.

Sunday

April 22nd

Pleasant - weather with moderate breeze and watch on shore nothing doing on board.

April 23rd

Pleasant - weather light breezes daylight - collect all hands employed putting up board and stowing down. Charles Hall deserter discharged Samuel Tilton George & Susan took her anchor for home.

April 24th

Pleasant - weather and moderate breeze at daylight - collect all hands employed setting up stowing down at 10 a.m. took for steam along side for on board 100 lbs. Charles Hall deserter.
