May 22^d

Overcast - Weather with moderate breeze from the Sward heading ESE and S part fresh breeze from S & W saw a school of porpoises

May 23^d

Lat 12.22 S
Long 9.48 E

Overcast - Weather with fresh breeze from S & W heading S & E and S part - time and weather the same steering E by S under all sail

May 24th

Lat 12.56 S
Long 11.19 E

Pleasant - weather with fresh breeze from S & W steering E by S saw porpoises at sunset - lighted two M and S part time and weather the same

May 25th

Lat 11.58 S
Long 11.38 E

Pleasant - weather and fresh breeze from S & W steering E by S at sunset - shortened sail M part - the same S part - moderate employed fitting rigging

Lat 10.50 S
Long 10.46 E

May 26th

Pleasant - weather with moderate breeze from S & W steering various courses M and S part time and weather the same

Lat 10.22 S
Long 10.26 E

May 27th

Pleasant - weather and moderate breeze from the S & W steering to the clear Lat 3 pm spoke B. Gasnolet and 7 min. went on board 7:30 returned on board M and S part light - air at 9 am each - Robinson and Philo came on board

May 28th

Pleasant - weather with light breezes from the Sward in company with B. Gasnolet 9 pm each - Robinson returned on board M and S the same employed in repairing sails and work on rigging

May 29th

Pleasant and light winds from S & W steering N and E saw two whale ships in sight - sent down R. J. sail for repairs M and S part - time and weather the same employed in mending J. sail three ships in sight
