May 30th

N. by E. employed in repairing S. topsail
H. and L. part - the same saw black
fish finished S. topsail and bent it -

May 31st

ward steering N. by E. employed in
various kinds of work H. and L. part -
the same at work and rigging and blacksmith-
ing

June 1st

Pleasant weather and light breeze from
ward heading O. part under all
sail nothing in sight H. and L. part -
time S. employed in blacksmithing
and so

June 2d

Lat 8.08. S
Long 12.06. E

Pleasant with light breeze from
S. by heading S. by E. sent down
H. sail H. and L. part - calm at
daylight - saw the land bear O. 25 mil

June 3d

Pleasant weather with light breeze
steering in for the land bent the main
at 2.30 P.M. lowered for pumpkins no
success at 6 P.M. came to anchor off
Ombria in 20 fathoms saw another ship
to leeward

Sunday

June 3d

Pleasant and calm at daylight collected
all hands and looked deep for whales
in sight - Ombria bear O. 15 miles sent
a boat in but could not land on account
of breakers

June 4th



Calm at daylight - lowered for boat to
cruise for pumpkins saw one and the
W. B. went on and struck line farter
the whale went off with the irons did not
see anything more for the day returned
board at sunset W. B. and line go to leeward

June 5th

Pleasant weather and calm lowered
our boat to cruise for one whale just
at sunset no chance at sunset returned
on board as ends this time for hours
