

Bk Desdemona Anchored off Ambrozeto

June 15th

Pleasant - weather and calm at daylight - hoisted and to set and lowered the boats to cruise for two 4 whales did not get a chance at them returned at sunset

June 16th

Pleasant with moderate breezes four boats down cruising did not see any for the day ship's officers employed breaking out

Sunday
June 17th

Pleasant - weather with light breezes from the South all hands on board employed in boiling no whales in sight finished boiling at 10 in morning 22 lbs

June 18th

Pleasant - weather with moderate breezes lowered four boats saw three whales did not get any ship's officers employed in storing down oil stores 44 lbs

June 19th

Pleasant - weather with light breeze lowered four boats to cruise returned at sunset no success ship's officers employed in storing down oil stores 28 lbs

June 20th

Pleasant - with moderate breezes lowered our boats as usual saw two whales but did not get a chance at them hoisted and anchored at daylight and did not leave at sunset - 10 fath

June 21st

Pleasant - with light air lowered our boats at daylight - saw two whales at 3 PM the whole acting boat and ryming of shore held on until sunset the ship came out - boats anchored for the night

June 22nd

Pleasant - with very light winds lowered our boats in the morning and returned at night - no success

June 23rd

Pleasant - with light air lowered our boats as usual returned at sunset did not see any whales for the day

June 24th

Pleasant - with light breeze boats down cruising returned at sunset no success
