

Remarks on Board Bb Deedemara

June 25th

Pleasant weather with light air lowered our boats as usual returned at sunset -

June 26th

Pleasant weather with light air lowered our boats at daylight to cruise returned again at sunset - no success

June 27th

Pleasant weather with light breezes lowered our boats as usual returned with no success

June 28th

Pleasant weather with very light breezes boats down chasing whales returned at sunset with no success

June 29th

Pleasant weather with moderate breezes from S.E. boats down after whales at 10 p.m. W.B. started and B.B. got close quite close by the same whale one man was struck by the whale and hurt - same yet nothing dangerous yet the whale alongside at 11 p.m. hooked and and cut him in finish sheet at 11 p.m.

June 30th

Pleasant weather with light breezes lowered our boats at daylight and returned again at sunset - no success got underway at 3 p.m. steering in to the S.E. ship keepers employed in cutting of blubber

Sunday July 1st

Pleasant weather with light breezes all hands on board nothing doing

July 2nd

Pleasant weather with light air lowered our boats as usual for whales at 4.40 p.m. W.B. started soon after the S.B.B. started blubber, the whales and both and kept on them all night - took them to the ship in the morning

July 3rd

Pleasant with light breezes at 10 p.m. hooked and cut finished at 4 p.m. employed in cutting of blubber

July 4th

Pleasant weather and calm lowered our boats at daylight - the boats about cutting of blubber and boiling the oil returned at sunset - no success
