August 17th

Foggy. Two boats cleared after timber
finished, boiling at daylight -
employed in getting wood, water
and recruits on board boats
returned with no success

August 18th

Pleasant - weather - collected all
hands at daylight, employed in
stowing down sail getting off wood,
water and recruits finished
sparring at dawn, discharge
Thomas Layles and Laurence Cochrane
ships, Jacob F. Dellefontaine hand

August 19th

Pleasant - with light winds
collected all hands at daylight - and
took anchor with a full load
of water and wood

August 20th

Pleasant - weather with light breeze
from the S.W. heading W. and
under all sail employed in stowing
water and wood

August 21st

Pleasant - weather with light
breeze from S.W. heading W. and
all sail set - employed in various
ships duties

August 22nd

Pleasant - weather with moderate
breeze from the S.W. heading W. and
all sail working S.W. employed in
various kinds of work

August 23rd

Pleasant - with fair winds working
S.W. under all sail employed in
washing ship inside

August 24th

Pleasant - with fresh breeze from
the S.W. heading S.W. under all
sail at 8 o'clock lowered for blackfish
and got one

August 25th

Pleasant - weather and fresh breeze
from S.W. heading S.W. under all
sail at 10 and 12 part maderia breeze
