April 18th

Pleasant and light breezes all on board employed in getting stores and provisions to the gun boat 14 barrels shoes 1 case S. Woods one of bread when Rego seaman met with a cut of the toes by stepping on a shoe box case sent him to the hospital

April 19th

Pleasant and light breezes all on board employed in getting wood from Lottie B. Manual Pena deserted

April 20th

Pleasant and light breezes all on board employed in getting oil Manual Pena deserted

April 21st - rose sea fish table full

Pleasant - employed discharging oil on board Lottie B. Manual Pena deserted

April 22nd

Pleasant - employed discharging oil ships. Edward Brahen second officer, Manual yelrene Manual nganzalo

St Vincent & Easter 1848

April 23rd

Pleasant and moderate breezes Edward Lott, George Kiele, William Cashman, David Miller, George Bingham, Jack Lemma all joined all seamen employed discharging oil put on board 49 cases

April 24th

Pleasant and fresh breezes employed getting the hold. George Kiele, George Bingham captured the above named men deserter sent on shore 1st ship

April 25th

Pleasant with fresh breezes employed storing water and provisions set fire to quite sick Edward Lott, William Cashman, David Miller, Jack Lemma all joined deserter

April 26th

Pleasant and moderate breezes already for sea they on board list men met on shore articles & Captain Berardo Demora, John Lepe, John de Lama, Frank Mantano, all King James, all seamen, John Rego came on board from the hospital
