August 7th

Main squalls lowered, as boats
for upland & B. Street, 10 AM got the
whale alongside at sunset made off
fast no sharks

August 8th

Pleasant breeze and boat
from 12 PM, shot the net - cutting
and boiling, saw several cows and
calves but did not get any.

August 9th

Main squalls employed boiling
and boats down no success

August 10th

Squalls finished, boiling at 9 AM
harbour at 8 PM boats down no
success

August 11th

Pleasant and moderate breeze
all day

August 12th

Pleasant and fresh breeze from
the breeze employed in storing oil
and boats down saw no success

August 13th

Pleasant and moderate breeze
employed in storing oil and boats
down in pursuit of whales no success

August 14th

Pleasant and fresh breeze from
about 12 PM both sides the breeze
boat started at 1 PM filled her and
all the boats prepared and one hour
for the breeze

August 15th

Pleasant and fresh breeze boats
down at B. Street and drained the
breeze cutting finished at sunset

August 16th

Pleasant weather and moderate
breeze boats down as usual. L.B.
started 8 AM prepared and one
hour for the breeze, got along
side 3 PM and hoisted and to leave
