Pleasant and very light breeze four boats down in pursuit of whales at 10 am S.B. struck 9th the whale along side 2.30 pm heaved an one eat him in got the head off 8.30 finished the body at 11 S part - weather the same heaved on the head 8.00 m finished at 12 m and started the work

Pleasant and moderate breeze from the S.W. heaving, was finished boiling 9 am S part light breeze employed setting up masts

Long 6.45 E

Overcast and light rain showers from the S.W. heaving S.E. and S part the same getting ready to stand down
