2 Nov. 1894.

Phalarope and light breezes under short sail. Saw a ship to leeward at 6 P.M. spoke by Buayare at 7.15. came in sight of Cape of Good Hope and weather the same continued storing oil.

sheep 8 mi. off at 11:45 got near enough

Mar 28th

Pleasant and moderate breeze from
S.W. heading E. all sail set - about
four boats for the whales working. Commenced
at 3 P.M. 8 - two L.B. started, the small
whaler, the others went off to S.W. got the
whales along side to 10 P.M. and race
calling gear at day light - hooked and one
at the whales in 8.30 finished.

Sept 7 or 8
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
