Feb-20th

Spatt 16 11 8

Pleasant weather and moderate breeze from the South steering W. at 11 all sail set and I put the same sight to the land & boom so on!

Feb 21st

Pleasant and high breezes came to anchor in St. Helene Harbor at 6 P.M. in 22 fathoms lost part employed working ship, at side and joining iron work.
