and two boys shipboard over Henry
Shears 2d Officer Frederick Chardling
3d Officer William Gordon further
officers

Feb 27th

. Pleasant - and most agreeable breeze - it
with an ability for both employment - lending
sails laid in the stern and blowing in the
white - Gibbon - Sander - Sander - Sander - Sander
and - mother - good - sea - men

Feb 28th

Phosant and high-buzzes getting
ready. far sea at 10 o'clock this, already
for once George Kildon and George Bingham
deserted George Kildon on purpose
and I went to the water worked up
70 and finished out side and took the
anchor at 1 P.M.

March 12th -

Overstated fresh water off mill
on Mount Elbert - but what George
Bingham deserves!

March 24

Phasant and strong trade. al.
The sea signs of an S. cold-
wind and almost the same.
George Bingham deserted.
