March 24

under way. Towing net at 10
p.m. at daylight passed on 9 a.m.
saw the beach on deck. finished
bailing at 10.45 a.m. saw the fort at
grey block stage. 1st bar SW 20 mi

March 25



Pleasant and strong breeze is
blowing the bar at working. Employers
bailing at 10.45 a.m. and bailing at 11 a.m.
at 1 p.m. strong breeze and rain squalls
bailing

March 26

Pleasant and fresh breeze according
to employers. Employers bailing at 10 a.m.
at 1 p.m. the same finished bailing
at daylight. at 10 a.m. sailing
same on board. core ship. and stage
off shore for up new grey block
ships

same land bar SW 40 mi

March 7th

Pleasant and moderate trade winds
heading SW shorter. sailed at sunset
at 1 p.m. fresh breeze employed
in storing oil

March 8th

Pleasant and fresh breeze heading
Oar. 1st bar employed storing oil finished
at 5 p.m. land bar SW 20 mi and
and 2nd bar - fine and weather the same
employed washing ship. in side

March 9th

Pleasant and moderate trade
heading SW all sail and 2nd bar -
squally
