April 19th

April 20th

Light variable winds and rain showers

with rain showers at 11 P.M. saw
a large sperm whale going quick
to S. E. lowered our boat but no
success four vessels in sight S. E.
and S. fort and all rocks the
camp and rain in torrents
set hold as usual nine ships in sight

April 21st

Pleasant and calm at 3 P.M.
light breeze struck from the S.
heading W. E. all sail at
sunset heading S. W. with a good
breeze from S. E. ten ships in
sight at 10 P.M. equal struck from
the S. E. with heavy rain thunders
and lightning S. fort - pleasant and
moderate breeze from S. E. heading
S. W. one bark in sight
