Pleasant clear weather and moderate breeze from the W. steering SE at 6 AM. Shortened down at 6 AM. A part - and weather the same steering SE at 6 AM. All sail set - at - hold as usual

Pleasant and fresh breeze from SE steering SE at 6 PM. At 6 PM. Some at sunset - reefed down at 6 AM. A part - the same vessel a barrel and a ship's lowermost

Smoky weather with strong breeze from SE steering SE at 6 AM. Moderate reef top sail at 6 AM. A part - moderate breeze

Foggy weather and light breeze from the W. steering SE at 6 AM. All sail at 6 AM. A part - rainy and foggy with pleasant weather and strong breeze from the W. saw the humpback going at 6 AM
