June 18th

Pleasant with strong breeze from the W. wind heading NW under short sail M and L part rain and fog blowing a moderate gale from the W at 12⁰⁰ more moderate

Pleasant and moderate breeze from NW steering S. W. saw one mackerel - jesse bomb. Oars saw a hum. bee. sea and calf also discovered. At 3.30 plan space for M and L part moderate breeze at daylight started off. Employed in bending new sails and killing pig.
