Pleasant over head with fresh breeze from W. heading S with whole topsails set whole and 2 part - weather the same employed shifting to the fore and between decks passed a schooner bound N. by E.

Pleasant weather and fresh breeze from the W. heading S with all sail set saw porpoises and 2 part - the same 10 am. the sun and some sea looking high under 1/2 day

Pleasant and fresh breeze from the W. heading S with all sail set saw porpoises and black fish and merchant vessel and 2 part - equally ship heading the same

Squally weather from the W. heading S with all sail set saw porpoises and 2 part - high breeze from the N.W. heading S with all sail set - employed cleaning ground on the windless - same the same
