

August Continued Trinity Island
Monday 23rd This morning at
early day the ship got under way & went
in a little bay below the town at Easter St.
Mr. in two fathom water. Left the whale &
went to the ship one boat stopping by him
Employed in fixing my boat. Southwick had
some nails. Started in her at about 11 AM
the anchor started let go the big one but
the Capt. got scared & got under way &
let up again let go the big anchor & in
two fathom water at two PM. saw contin-
ues good at sundown retrieved the boat
at the whale. So ends

Tuesday 24th Tuesday morning at break
of day started for the boat that was by the
whale. The whale came up at one PM
& pretty well chewed up hooked on & towed
him 4 hours in to 15 fathom water.
As the two boats on board got the ship
under way & run down & let so the anchor
hook him along side & commenced cutting
a four PM all through or get under &
went to get up to a better place there being
a light N. wind Employed in cutting
boards pieces. So ends

Wednesday 25th This morning
at 9 AM came to anchor in a small bay below
the town, raised anchor sent the second & third
mate down. Second mate struck. then sent the
mate to chase. they turned him up at 4 PM
off the Dutch cap. Hooked on & towed about half
hour when he sank in 35 fathom water sent
two boats to the ship one came back with a
buoy & orders to leave & come on board. got on board
at eleven PM started the works and boiled with
the watch for three hours each. So ends

Thursday 26th This morning employed in
boiling finished boiling at 9 AM. Cleared up & set
up sick at two PM lowered two boats & went
to the whale one boat came on board at eight & this
momently PM. the other stayed all night -
Second mate sick & so is the third. The Boat
gun having kicked him & also one man forward
So ends

Friday 27th This day weather fine
with fine N. wind. Still trying by the
whale with the Starboard boat was retrieved at
Eight AM. by the Starboard boat went on-
board at 10 AM got the scho. under way & beat
her up then ran a line to the ship to see
if we could haul her up & the line parted, kept
her off for her anchoring at the same place
reached there & let go the anchor at Five PM
parted the sails and got supper. Second mate went
on shore for Mr. Siler he could do
nothing. Third mate better. So ends calm

Saturday 28th This day weather fine & light
air from N. W. At seven AM lowered
my boat & carried the second mate up
in the Bark Triton for a passage to
St. Helena it being his request & the
Captains consent. Capt. Small of serial
bark came on board saw the Capt. & con-
sented to take him came on board at
five PM. got supper & went on shore for
two hours came off at 9 PM. calm
Our Phillips quite smart. So ends
