

Remarks on board. Schu.
 February 24th 1870 Thursday 24th
 This twenty four hours commences with
 very fine weather & wind from West at N
 steering N E. Employed in coopers
 two barrels & filling them with water
 middle part heading to the East
 under by sails & jib. At daylight made
 sail ahead E S E. At 10 AM set the
 fore sail, main sail, employed in all sort
 of work about ship Lat 32.35 S
 Long 74.51 W

Friday 25th
 This twenty four hours
 commences with very good weather
 & wind from the Southward steering
 E S E & by S. At sundown furlled
 the two after sails & set the by sail
 furlled the two outer jibs. Middle part
 quite moderate towards morning calm
 at daylight a light breeze sprang up
 from the N. West. Steered under all
 sail E S E. Saw jammers employed
 in cleaning iron. So ends with increas-
 ing breeze Lat 32.25 S
 Long 74.12 W

Sat 26th
 This twenty four hours
 opens with light but increasing breeze
 from N West steering E S E at sun
 down shortened sail & steered E S E
 middle part the same latter part
 made sail excepting fore sail steered
 E S E. Employed in cutting off the
 foot of the fore sail. At day got a squall & it
 passed us 2.37 West So ends
 Lat 32.44 S Long 74.19 W

 Sunday 27th of February This twenty four
 hours commences with very strong breeze from
 N W steering E S E employed in breaking
 out bread. At sundown shortened sail
 as usual middle part steering the
 same. At sunrise set the fore sail
 at seven luffed up the East Base
 not seen anything at 12 M luffed
 to East by Starboard So ends with wind
 N W. Lat 32.41 S Long 74.1 East
 by noon & by our lunar 114 West at 11
 Lat 32.40 South

Monday 28th
 This twenty four hours opens
 with a good N West wind steering E by
 North under main by sail fore sail & jib
 have seen nothing. At four wind hauled
 down head and E by South furlled the
 jib top sail & middle part heading to the
 E by S under the jib & jib in fore sail
 & by sail. At daylight set the jib top sail
 but soon hauled it down again it breezing
 up quite strong So ends Lat 33.00
 Long 74.8 E

Tuesday the 1st
 This twenty four hours
 opens with quite a good breeze from the
 E N E steering by the wind heading E S E
 have seen nothing north not middle
 increasing winds. At 3 AM wore
 ship set the fore by sail & took up
 the main by sail. At four 1 PM took
 up the fore by sail. At seven
 called them down from aloft &
 took the main by sail. The jib & sail
 in the jib top sail. Day on E S with
 a strong breeze broke out water
