 To day opens with good

 Employed in scraping mainmast
 down the soft-top sail middle & scatter
 the same. So ends
 Lat 14.50 South
 Long 1.16 East

Thursday 31st
 To day first part steering West
 wind S. E. Employed in flushing &
 scraping middle part the same
 Scatter also. So ends
 Lat 15.52 South
 Long 1.28 West

Friday April the First
 This twenty
 four hours opens with light breeze
 from S. E. kept her soft to W.
 N. West middle weather the same
 At 11.15 AM furled the main sail & soft-
 top sail & the main top sail
