

Journal of June Continued 1870

Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> This month four hours ahead with good breeze from the South Steered S. by W. At two P.M. tacked again. At four P.M. tacked in shore at six P.M. tacked off shore again. Middle & latter quite moderate heading from S. W. to S. W. by W. Employed ship duty so ends  
Lat 1.17.0 S Long 7.19.0

Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> This day opens with very light winds Steering by the wind heading S. W. Saw two humpbacks & porpoises Middle the same latter almost calm saw one sail. Employed in picking potatoes so ends  
Lat 1.12 S Long 6.36.4

Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> This day opens with very light winds Steering by the wind heading S. W. Saw one sail & humpbacks Middle very moderate, more ship at at 40 P.M. headed South latter the same Employed in making vinegar stuff so ends  
Lat 1.12 S Long 6.16.0

Friday 24<sup>th</sup> This day opens with calm & light air Steering by the wind heading East & S. East. Saw one sail 10 P.M. saw schooner bound to Swazie. Capt. went on board. Saw blackfish Middle weather the same Steering to the Westward At six P.M. tacked heading to the S. E. Day ends in a calm  
Lat 1.22 S Long 6.12.0

Saturday June 25<sup>th</sup>

This day opens with a calm & at two P.M. had a light breeze from the South Steering by the wind heading S. W. Saw porpoises Employed in putting a piece on the head of my boat Middle calm & light breeze Steering to the Eastward in the fore part of the night & the latter to the S. W. At daylight Steered by the wind heading S. E. Day ends with very little wind  
Lat 1.50 S Long 6.05.0

Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> This day opens with very light winds Steering by the wind heading S. E. wind from S. W. at four down calm Middle the same At eight P.M. had a light breeze from S. W. & S. E. W. Steered by the wind heading from S. E. to S. S. E. & ends  
Lat 2.10 S Long 6.24

Monday 27<sup>th</sup> This day opens with very light breeze heading by the wind S. E. by East Middle & latter calm At eight P.M. saw two humpbacks chased them with all three boats but could not strike came on board at noon, whales going off N. E. so ends  
Lat 2.18 S Long 6.29

Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> This day opens with a very light breeze from the S. W. with calm Steering by the wind heading S. S. E. & by E. Employed in washing ship & making bread & ship duty Middle light air heading S. E. & South latter the same  
Lat 2.30 S Long 7.08.0
