

July Continued Sunday 27<sup>th</sup>

To day weather fine. first part employed in cutting off six all cut in. At seven P.M. all cut up in horse pieces & decks cleared commenced minding down several whale. Middle weather good. At twelve midnight commenced minding of the boat. Latter employed in minding all minding at 12 noon. Had seen several whale. Lowered the third mate & he ran over him & came 21 am board so ends

Monday 28<sup>th</sup>

To day weather fine. Down several whale employed in minding & finished at six P.M. A heavy fine barrel fine. Middle weather fine. Latter run four casks of oil & chased two whale. Third mate started & milled having only one iron up in the head of the boat so ends

Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup>

This day weather fine with strong breeze & a heavy swell from the South. Down several whale. Middle fine. Latter saw several whale. Lowered all three boats but could not strike so ends

Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> Weather fine. Down several all three boats after that. At One O'clock P.M. Harbor boat struck & turned him up & all three hooked on & towed until 12 midnight & let go the anchor & the Capt. went to the ship. He being three miles to windward got to the

Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> Continued

Ship at 2 P.M. At day light made all sail & came down to the harbor. Got along side & hooked on to his head. At 4 P.M. his after parts sinking bad & the sharks eating like time having cut him most all up. Employed in cutting in 13 fathom water so ends

Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> day open fine. Employed in cutting horse pieces finished cutting at three P.M. At four hours up our anchor & ran up the coast three or four miles with a N.W. wind & let go anchor in 10 fathom water. Furlled the sails & set the watch at nine P.M. Middle weather fine. At day light commenced minding at 10 & started the two works. Down several whale. Capt. lowered but could not get on so ends

Friday 29<sup>th</sup>

To day weather fine. Capt. & third-mate minding whale. At five P.M. coated down whale making 12 bbls. Middle weather fine. Latter that saw run two casks of oil & chased several whale so ends

Saturday 30<sup>th</sup>

To day weather fine employed in cleaning bone & chasing whale. Capt. went on shore to see if he could not trade for some potatoes & come off with about one bushel. It being all the natives had. Middle moderate. Latter at eight P.M. lowered for whale. Harbor boat struck & then turned her whale up in about twenty minutes. Capt. hooked on & helped tow & sent the third mate to get the ship under way. The whale being two miles to leeward so ends
