

Homeward bound September of 1840

Saturday 10th This day very light & variable winds steering N. by E. & N. by W. Down one sail steering to the S. E. four men sick & off duty three with fever & one with sore feet. Captain worse but his wife & babe better now self up around but not very well. So ends Lat 2. 40 Long 27. 17

Sunday 11th To day weather very moderate steering N. by N. All the sick ones some better Middle & better the same So ends Lat 2. 15 Long 28. 30

Monday 12th To day weather fine steering N. by N. wind S. E. & light. Down a fin back. one man a little worse the rest gaining Employed in ship duty so ends Lat 2. 00 Long 29. 01

Tuesday 13th To day fine with light winds steering N. by N. at Six P. M. kept her off N. by N. Middle & better the same. David S. E. all some better of the fever So ends Lat 1. 08 Long by D. 32. 07 by Chro 32. 48

Wednesday 14th To day fine with light S. E. breeze steering N. by N. Down one sail Middle & better with a good breeze So ends Sick ones improving Lat 0. 10 N. 35. 28 W.

Thursday 15th To day weather fine with a good S. E. wind steering N. by N. Employed in ship duty & at Chandon were. Ship steered North Sat. One Ith more again steered N. by North. have seen nothing North employed in ship duty so ends Sick ones gaining Lat 1. 34 North Long by D. 38. 21 by Chro 37. 11

Friday 16th To day good breeze from the S steering N. by N. A ship were steering N. by N. Middle the same. employed in the rigging scraping spade plates at 10. filled ship steered N. by N. the same Sick ones improving Lat 2. 26 North Long by D. 39. 59 by Chro 38. 11

Saturday 17th To day weather fine with a good breeze from South. steering N. by N. Middle & better the same & employed in the rigging The sick ones some better Samuel St. Jago turned to So ends Lat 2. 51 Long by Chro 39. 57 Long by D. 40. 26

Sunday 18th To day fine light breeze from the South steering N. by N. Down a fin back Middle & better the same Three men off duty Sick but improving Lat 5. 48 Long D. 42. 20 Long. 41. 03

Monday 19th To day fine with light South winds & light squalls steering N. by N. Down one sail steering N. by N. Middle & better the same & two men Sick & off duty So ends Lat 6. 49 N. by Chro 42. 25 W.
