

Remarks on Board Bark Gay Head W. S. Ashley Master

Thursday March 19th

Came in with fresh breeze from south and steering for Honolulu at 5. Put five miles south of Diamond Head

Friday March 20th

Came in with fine weather and moderate breeze from south. And ship off Honolulu waiting for Captain Fisher to join the ship. At sundown Diamond Head bears by compass S. W. 25 miles off

Saturday March 21st

Came in with fine weather from S. W. At 12-30 took a boat crew and went on shore to see the Captain and get my letters. Found him well and he was to come on board Monday

Sunday March 22nd

Note

Came in with fine weather and gentle breeze from south. Ship off and on Honolulu William Graff the ship's steering boy took the ship's life preserver and left the ship we suppose to swim on to the shore which time he left no one knows

Monday March 23rd

Came in with light variable air and calms. And trying to work the ship toward Honolulu for the Captain and our stores. At sundown Diamond Head bears by compass West 12 miles off

Tuesday March 24th

Came in with moderate breeze from W. S. W. And trying all day to beat up to Honolulu. At Sundown Diamond Head bears S. W. by W 32 miles off

Wednesday March 25th

Came in with light to fresh breeze from S. W. Ship on and off of Honolulu
