Arrived back to Elizabethport Tues April 3rd 5:00 P.M.

Wednesday April 4th
Loaded 209 ton Chat Coal for J. W. Collierworth at Key Port N.Y.
Arrived back to Elizabeth April 14th 7:30 A.M.

Wednesday May 9th
Loaded 394 ton Pea Coal for the Church Catholic Rectory
at Westchester N.Y. Arrived back to Elizabeth May 17th
and was towed to Brewster Bay Dock

May 10th Shipped to Pange Church Church and made three trips
to Pangeport and trips to Boston. Did not like the job so
asked the Rose for a Harbor Boat

Sunday Aug 5th 1917
Took the Boat #32. for same company

Loaded at Elizabeth 294.13 ton Pea Coal 134 St. River for
Columbia University. Arrived at Edgewater Aug 15th

at Buena Canal

Left the Lehigh Coal & Navigation Co

Oct 10th 1917
Went to work as bow watchman on ship New Haven - Capt F. B. Whiting
Fall River Maine

Dec 11th 1917
Left Fall River Maine and went to work again for the
Lehigh Coal & Navigation Co Boat #32

Dec 24th 1917
At Elizabethport loaded 372 ton Pea Coal for Devoe
Paint Co Buena Canal. Arrived back to port Jan 1st 1918

1920 July 18th 1920
Still working for Lehigh Coal & Nav Co. On Boat #32
