Sunday Dec 24th 1843
Begins with rainy weather at 4 PM the hands
to the 2 headed to the SSE employed in setting
up the main top Mast Rigger at 4 AM moved
Ship to SE at 5 AM the wind hauled to the WSW
made sail and steered SSE Set by Oct 37.05 Long 60.10

Monday Dec 25th 1843
Begins with fresh breezes from the WSW and cloudy
double reefed the top sail steering S by E and put
the same latter more moderate made sail

Tuesday Dec 26th 1843
Begins with gentle breezes from the SW and cloudy
steering S by E Mid and latter parts strong
breezes and squally double reefed Set 35.11 Long 58.18

Wednesday Dec 27th 1843
Begins with fresh gales from the SW and squally
steering S by E Mid part the same latter moderate
made sail saw a Brig heading to the W employed
in ships duty Set by Oct 34.09 Long 57.24

Thursday Dec 28th 1843
Begins with light breezes from the SSE and cloudy
heading SE at 8 AM to SE at 12 Mid the
hauled to S heading SSE latter strong winds and
rainy close reefed the top sails. Oct 35

Friday Dec 29th 1843
Begins with fresh gales from the S and squally
steering SSE Mid and latter parts moderate &
clear made all sail Set by Oct 34.00 Long 58.00

Saturday Dec 30th 1843
Begins with gentle breezes from the SSW
and cloudy saw hump back & steering SSE
Mid and latter parts strong breezes and cloudy
reefed the top sails Oct 35

for the Pacific Ocean
13 Sunday Dec 31st 1843
Begins with fresh breezes from the S and
cloudy steering SSE unpleasant weather but
we must be patient in all things let us bless
the name of God for all the good he does for
us and latter parts blowing hard and heavy squalls
close reefed the main top sail and took in the fore

Monday Jan 1st 1844
Begins with fresh gales from the SSW and
cloudy steering S by E saw a Brig steering E
a new year has commenced this day has been
good to me the year past I may I ever put
my trust in him Lord give me thy blessing
this year Mid and latter parts much the same
rainy set double reefed top sail Oct 33.50 Long 49.00

Tuesday Jan 2nd 1844
Begins with strong breezes from SSW and rainy
steering S by E Mid and latter part the same
close reefed the top sails Set by Oct 33.30 Long 59.05

Wednesday Jan 3rd 1844
Begins with fresh gales from the SSW and
cloudy steering S by E rough weather Mid and
latter parts the same took in the fore top sail
& reefed the fore sail Oct 33.25 Long 57.30

Thursday Jan 4th 1844
Begins with fresh gales from SSW and heavy
squalls of wind and rain steering S by E
Mid and latter parts moderate the wind NW
made all sail steered SE saw a Brig heading
SW Set by Oct 33.03 Long 57.10

Friday Jan 5th 1844
Begins with light breezes from the NW and
clear steering SE employed in ships duty
Mid and latter part the same Set 32.35 Long 53.10

Saturday Jan 6th 1844
Begins with light winds and calm at 4 PM lowered the boats
to practice the men Mid and latter parts much the
same saw four Barks Set 32.34 Long 52.10
