Friday Sept 4th 1846

Begins with gentle SSW wind steering West by N in company with the Wm & Henry and latter the same

Lat 9.42 S Long 121.30 E

Saturday Sept 5th 1846

Begins with gentle breezes from S steering W at day light heavy showers in rain entered sandalwood Strait latter clear saw sandalwood Is and Flores So End

Sunday Sept 6th 1846

Begins with gentle Easterly wind and clear at 8 PM SW Point of sandalwood bore W by S dist 18 miles saw Flores & Sumbawa to the S steering West in company with the Wm & Henry and latter part Calm the current set 2 miles per hour to the S and in sight both sides of the Strait

Lat 9.10 Long 120.00 E

Monday Sept 7th 1846

Begins with light breezes from E steering W by N the land in sight both sides this is dull with rain and latter much the same Lat 9.00 Long 120.00

Tuesday Sept 8th 1846

Begins with at light easterly wind set the main royal & all the steering sails steering W spoke the Wm & H saw the land both sides and latter part gentle breeze Lat 9.05 S Long 119.00 E

Wednesday Sept 9th 1846

Begins with gentle breezes from the E steering W at night Sumbawa to the S dist 15 miles and part light air & latter fresh breezes steering down the land spoke the Wm & H

Lat 9.00 Long 118.55 E

Thursday Sept 10th 1846

Begins with gentle breezes from the E steering W by S Sumbawa dist 10 miles to the S and part Calm latter light breezes running down the land Lat 9.10 Long 119.10

Friday Sept 11th 1846

Begins with gentle trades at 4.4 PM took in sail off the west end of Sumbawa on day black at 6 PM SW point bore SW dist 15 miles at day light entered Allas Strait S End

Saturday Sept 12th 1846

Begins with fresh trades at 1 PM anchored off Bally in 12 fathoms of water

Thursday Sept 17th 1846

Begins with fine weather - taking off recruits at 6 am took the anchor and stood out to sea So End

Friday Sept 18th 1846

Begins with fresh trades heading SSW the Wm & Henry in company with the 550 Sfr and latter part much the same Lat 10.00 Long 115.28 E

Saturday Sept 19th 1846

Begins with fresh trades and clear - heading SSW saw nothing and latter part the same Lat 11.18 Long 114.32

Sunday Sept 20th 1846

Begins with gentle trades at 2 PM took to the E saw nothing at 12 and took to the SSW latter same and sent us some oil and carry us home

Lat 11.52 S Long 114.54 E
