

March Trade of New Bedford

Wednesday Aug^r 1st 1849

First port saw Sumbawa to the N
batter came to anchor at Pejou in 90
fathoms in hopes to get some recruits
but found nothing

Thursday Aug^r 2^d 1849

Water put run down and anchored off
Bally

Sunday Aug^r 12th 1849

The last 10 days staying at Bally getting
recruits water &c at day light took the
anchor and stood out for sea 50 cns

Tuesday Aug^r 16th 1849

All this day fresh trades and clear heading
S by W saw fin backs employed in stowing
recruits &c Lat 11.58 S Long 111.30 E

Monday Aug^r 20th 1849

All this day a half of gale of wind and
has been for a week Lat 11.31 S Long 110.60 E

Wednesday Aug^r 22nd 1849

All this day strong trades saw fin backs
back in the fly jibb boom & bow boat. all
ready for whales & grant us some our-ships
has begun to leak a little Lat 20.06 Long 109.50

Tuesday Aug^r 28th 1849

All this day strong trades at mid night
saw a sail steering NW Lat 23.30 S Long 105.45 E

Friday Aug^r 31st 1849

At day light saw a large sperm whale
at 8 days on bow and struck him at 12 M
took him to the ship Lat 25.23 Long 106.25

Saturday Sept 1st 1849

All this day fine weather cut in the
whale and began to hoil found another
of our try pots broke lanes us but
one Lat 25.42 Long 106.58 E

Wednesday Sept 5th 1849

All this day fine weather first port
finished boiling Lat 25.42 Long 104.18

Friday Sept 7th 1849

First port calm water light breeze from
the west employed in stowing down
saw fin backs Lat 26.01

Tuesday Sept 11th 1849

All this day light winds and clear saw
fin backs first port setting up Shooker
batter took out the try pots and filed
the bottom could not see that they were
broken put the back again
Lat 26.45 S Long 108.30 E

Saturday Sept 15th 1849

All this day strong trades and clear saw
fin backs & grant us some oil
Lat 25.04 Long 107.60 E

Monday Sept 17th all this day fresh

trades saw fin backs now for Cape Lewis
1 where the wind blows
Lat 25.26 S Long 107.20

Saturday Sept 29th 1849

All this day baffling winds and a heavy
smell Lat 29.33 Long 108.50 E
