




30. Sunday, June 22nd 1857

 P.M. took off the W.N.W. at sun set shortened sail
 Middle part the same, latter part fresh breeze
 from S.W. Made sail heading N.W. one sail
 In sight  Lat. 38. 36. N
 Long. 71. 55. W


31. Monday, June 23rd 1857
 Begins with fresh breezes from the S.
 heading W.N.W. cloudy weather at sun set
 shortened sail latter part fresh breezes from
 the W. Made sail heading S.W. the water
 employed in ships duty.  Lat. 38. 22. N
 Long. 72. 15. W


32. Tuesday, June 24th 1857
 Begins with moderate breezes from the S.
 heading S.W. at sun set, tacked to the N.W.
 & shortened sail Middle the same latter
 part Made sail heading S.W. & two sails in
 sight so birds.  Lat. 38. 20
 Long. 71. 20


33. Wednesday, June 25th 1857
 Begins with moderate breezes from S.W. steering
 S.W. at sun set shortened sail, by the words
 Middle the same, latter part wind S.W. & showery
 made sail steering S.W.  Lat. 38. 05. N
 Long. 71. 45. W

34. Thursday, June 26th 1857
 Begins with moderate breezes from the S.W.
 steering S.W. one sail in sight at 9 P.M. saw
 the Peak of Pico, bearing N.W. 50 miles Dist
 cloudy weather Middle the same latter part light
 breezes from N.W. heading N.W. Pangel Pico & St. George
 In sight Pico bearing N.W. at 12. near Dist 20 miles
 Lat. 38. 00. N
 Long. 72. 35. W

35. Friday, June 27th 1857
 Begins with light breezes & variable heading
 to the W. wind. Middle the same, latter part
 moderate breezes from S.W. Made sail heading
 S.W. for Pico.  Lat. 38. 53. N
 Long. 72. 35. W

36. Saturday, June 28th 1857
 Begins with moderate breezes from S.W.
 heading S.W. In shore, at 5 P.M. sent one boat
 on shore with the 3rd officer & one man on a
 visit at 7 the boat came off spoke the Bark
 Pave of N. Capt. Kessels 26. Months 6 or 10
 Pangel Pico St. George & Sancer. In sight at sun
 set shortened sail heading S.W. Middle the same
 latter part light breezes & variable with showers of rain
 so birds.  Lat. 38. 08. N

37. Sunday, June 29th 1857
 Begins with moderate breeze from the S.W. at 1. half
 sent my boat on shore on Pico at 1. the boat came off
 with the two hundred yesterday & three from to ship.
 came in Portuguese Frank, French & Danish Middle
 part light air & variable heading off shore latter part
 fresh breezes from S.W. breeze variable
 saw Pico sail  Lat. 38. 09. N
 Long. 72. 25. W
