Monday, July the 7th 1851

45. Begins with light breeze from the N heading, N & N Middle part short sail, latter part made sail, light breeze & visible one sail in sight, saw Flores.
Lat. 38. 37. N
Long. 20. 20. W

Tuesday, July the 8th 1851

46. Begins with calm weather, Middle part short sail, light breeze from the E & steering N & N. Latter part moderate made sail steering N & N. Sailed Flores & bore in sight, spoke the English, Bark Home of Ipswich from Sable Island to Rio Janeiro,
Lat. 39. 04. N
Refuels plenty. Long. 31. 00. W

Wednesday, July the 9th 1851

47. Begins with fresh breeze from the E & steering N & N. Flores & bore in sight. At 1 P.M. spoke the Ship Sylph of Gen. Haven, 320 tbs, Capt. Gardner. The John & Edward in company. Middle part short sail, latter part made sail, southerly variable at 8 AM lowered one boat, & pulled to the shore at Flores did not land. At 11. Came on board, no boat.
Refuels plenty. Lat. 39. 29. S
Long. 31. 25. W

Thursday, July the 10th 1851

48. Begins with moderate breeze from the E southerly variable Flores & bore in sight at 6 P.M. spoke the Brig Charlotte of Sag Harbor Capt. Winters, 11. Months 500 tbs. Middle part short sail, latter part light breeze from the E. Made sail heading N & N. no boat.
Lat. 39. 34. N
Long. 31. 28. W

Cruising off the Western Islands, July 1851

Friday, July the 11th 1851

49. Begins with light breeze from the E heading 2 P.M. Flores & bore in sight. At sun set tacked to Westward & took in sail. Five sail in sight. Middle part the same latter part fresh breeze southerly variable. Lat. 39. 24. N
Long. 31. 45. W

Saturday, July the 12th 1851

50. Begins with fresh breeze from the E heading N & N at 2 P.M. tacked to the S & Flores & bore in sight. At sun set tacked to the N & N. & took in sail. Two sail in sight latter part moderate breeze from the S. Made sail southerly variable three ships in sight. no boat.
Lat. 39. 12. N
Long. 31. 50. W

Sunday, July the 13th 1851

51. Begins with moderate breeze from the S. southerly variable Flores & bore in sight, & three ships. Middle part heading to the Westward under short sail, latter part made sail. Moderate breeze from the N heading N & N saw 10. sail.
Lat. 39. 36. N
Long. 31. 50. W

Monday, the 14th 1851

52. Begins with light breeze from the N. southerly variable Flores & bore in sight. Middle part under short sail, latter part made sail southerly variable several reefs in sight spoke the Ship Dorrill of Boston from New Orleans 26 days Bound to Leg Horn.
