Wednesday August, the 12th/51

82. Begins with fresh breezes from the N. steering S by E. By day saw St. George & Lucia in sight. Middle part under short sail, at 5.00 saw St. Michael, wind N by W, made sail & luffed to the wind heading S. Lat. 31. 24. N Long. 26. 06. W

St. Mary's Board South.

Thursday, August, the 14th

1. Begins with moderate breezes from N by W heading S. at 1 P.M. saw St. Mary's, bearing S by E & dist 30 miles. Middle & latter part light breezes & variable. St. Mary's in sight to the eastward. Lat. 31. 16. N Long. 25. 08. W

Friday August, the 15th

2. Begins with air from the S.W. heading S by E. Middle & latter part the same, the watch employed in fitting the main top gallant back stays. &c. Lat. 35. 53. N Long. 25. 00. W

Saturday, August, the 16th/51

3. Begins with light air from the S.W. heading N by W all hands employed in turning in, & setting up the main rigging. Middle part heading S by E, latter when the watch employed in seizing up & setting up the fore rigging two sail in sight caught one black fish. Lat. 35. 24. N Long. 24. 42. W

Sunday, August, the 17th/51

4. Begins with calm weather. Middle & latter part light breezes from the S. steering S by W, one sail in sight. Lat. 34. 50. N Long. 24. 41. W

Monday, August, the 18th/51

5. Begins with light breezes from the S. steering S by W. Middle & latter part the same, no wind. Lat. 32. 34. N Long. 24. 42. W
boiling black fish,

Tuesday, August, the 19th/51

6. Begins with light breezes from the S. steering S by W. Middle & latter part gentle breezes from S.W. saw one sail steering to the westward. Painted the Bow Boat. Lat. 31. 31. N Long. 24. 40. W

Wednesday, August, the 20th/51

7. Begins with gentle breezes from S.W. steering S by W. Middle & latter part strong breezes & calm. Lat. 28. 58. N
Manoeuvred heavy off. Duty with the General, Long. 24. 48. W

Thursday, August, the 21st/51

8. Begins with fresh breezes from S.W. steering S by W. Middle part the same, latter part light breezes & variable, with rain saw one sail steering to the westward. No. 10. Lat. 26. 50. N
Rose fore & main booms Long. 25. 00. W

Friday, August, the 22nd/51

9. Begins with fresh breezes from the S. with hard showers of rain, steering S by W. At 4 P.M. took top gallant sail & fly jib. Middle the same, latter part light breezes & variable, from S.W. to S. at top gallant sail & fly jib heading to the westward. Lat. 24. 52. N Long. 25. 31. W
