Saturday, August 1. 25<sup>th</sup> 1857

10. Begins with light breezes from S.W. heading N. employed for repairing the Gaff-top sail at 2. tacked to the S.E. at 5. bent the Gaff-top sail. Middle part - below, latter part - light breezes from the N steering S.W. Painted the waist-board - 10 ends.

Lat. 24. 28. N

Took the North-east trades.

Long. 25. 24. W

Sunday, August 2. 26<sup>th</sup> 1857

11. Begins with light breezes from the N. steering S.W. Middle & latter part - gentle breeze from N.W. with one sail on right steering S.W. (changed signal with American flag).

Lat. 22. 20. N

Long. 25. 40. W

Monday, August 25<sup>th</sup> 1857

12. Begins with fresh breezes from N.W. steering S.W. Middle & latter part - S.W. light breezes painted the foreboard head - one sail on right.

Tuesday, August 26<sup>th</sup> 1857

13. Begins with light breezes from the N. steering S.W. Middle & latter part - light breezes steering S.W. two sail on right all hands employed in breaking out & coopersing Bread & Flour, 10 ends.

St. Antonio

Wednesday August 27<sup>th</sup> 1857

14. Begins with gentle breezes from the S.W. steering S.W. heading N. weather. Middle part steering S.W. light breezes at 5. S.W. saw St. Antonio one of the Cape Verde Islands. Bearing S.W. distance 20 miles. latter part steering S. all employed in coopersing Bread & Flour.

Outward Bound September 1857.

Thursday, August - the 28<sup>th</sup> 1857

15. Begins with light trades from the S. steering S. weather another Middle part steering S. latter part S by E. light breezes & variable saw four sail all hands breaking out & coopersing Bread & Flour.

Long. 24. 50. W

Friday August - the 29<sup>th</sup> 1857

16. Begins with light airs from the eastward steering S by E. Middle part from the N steering S latter part S by E finished coopersing. Two sail on right.

Lat. 12. 54. S

Long. 24. 26. W

Saturday, August - the 30<sup>th</sup> 1857

17. Begins with light breezes from the N. steering S by E. Middle part - below latter part light breezes from S.W. heading S.W. Three sail on right - 10 ends.

Sunday, August 31<sup>st</sup> 1857

18. Begins with light breezes from S.W. heading N. at 1. tacked to the S.E. saw four sail Middle part heading S. wind N.W. latter part strong breezes from S.W. & squally heading S.E.

Long. 24. 15. W

Monday September the 1<sup>st</sup> 1857

19. Begins with strong breezes from S.W. heading S.E. dark cloudy weather. Middle & latter part heading S.E. wind S.W. saw seven sail - 10 ends.

Rose New Main top sail Reef taken
