Monday Sept the 2^d 1851

20. Begins with moderate breeze from the S.W. heading S.E. by E. hazy weather Middle part heading S. latter part S.W. strong breeze, saw four sail, the watch employed in repairing the main top gallant sail.

Tuesday Sept the 3^d 1851

21. Begins with fresh breeze from the S.W. heading S.W. Middle part the same latter part light breeze from S.W. backed to the N. saw four sail. Repaired the fore top sail.

Thursday

Wednesday Sept. 4th 1851

22. Begins with light breeze from S.W. heading N. sent the fore top sail, spoke the Schooner Franklin of New London, Capt. Williams, Middle part heading N.E. by E. latter part S.E. by E. saw two sail. Employed in repairing the fore sail, no birds.

Friday Sept the 5th 1851

23. Begins with fresh breeze from the S. heading S.E. sent the fore sail, Middle & latter part heading S. strong easterly current, employed in Middle stitching the main top sail & gaff & banding the top sail, saw two sail.

Saturday Sept. 6th 1851

24. Begins with fresh breeze from S.W. heading S.E. sent the main top sail & gaff Middle & latter part S.E. by E. saw one sail, no birds.

Sunday Sept the 7th 1851

25. Begins with moderate breeze from S.W. by E. heading S.E. by E. Middle & latter part light breeze & variable, saw much the same saw six sail, no birds.

Monday Sept the 8th 1851

26. Begins with light breeze from S.W. heading N. saw black fish, Middle & latter part light breeze & variable, from S.E. to S.W. stronger variable, cloudy weather.

Tuesday Sept the 9th 1851

27. Begins with light variable winds, Middle part from S.W. to S. with rain heading S.E. latter part heading N. saw two sail.

Long. 18. 15. W

Wednesday Sept the 10th 1851

28. Begins with fresh breeze from S.W. with showers of rain, heading S.E. took in top gallant sails of fore & gaff top sail, Middle part the same, latter part more moderate made sail took ship heading N.E. by E. saw three sail.

Thursday Sept the 11th 1851

29. Begins with fresh breeze from S.W. heading N. S. & backed to the S. at 4, backed to the N. Middle & latter part heading N.E. by E. & N.W. saw three sail.
