32. Begins with fresh breeze from the S heading N.W. Middle & latter part moderate so ends.

Monday, Sept. the 15th

33. Begins with light breeze heading N.W. Middle & latter part light trades from S.W. heading S.W. by the wind. The watch employed in Middle stitching the fore spinn. so ends.

Tuesday, Sept. the 16th

34. Begins with light trades from S.W. heading S.W. by the wind. Middle & latter part heading S.W. by S. the watch employed in turning up & setting rigging. saw one sail steering N.W.

Wednesday, Sept. the 17th

35. Begins with moderate trades heading S.W. by S. the watch employed in setting up the main top mast backstays & rigging. Middle & latter part heading S.W. with light showers of rain.

Thursday, Sept. the 18th 1851

36. Begins with light trades heading S.W. with showers of rain. Middle the same. latter part strong breeze took in top gallt. sail & fly jib heading S.W. saw one sail steering N.W.

Long. 26. 35. W

Friday, Sept. the 19th

37. Begins with fresh trades heading S.W. by S. set top gallt. sail & fly jib. Middle & latter part strong breeze took in top gallt. sail & fly jib & reefed the fore top sail. under sail in sight steering S.W.
Lat. 8. 40. S
Long. 27. 00. W

Saturday, Sept. the 20th

38. Begins with fresh trades heading S.W. by S. set the main top gallt. sail & fly jib. Middle & latter part moderate trades all sail heading S.W. by S. so ends.
Lat. 10. 50. S
Long. 27. 40. W

Sunday, Sept. the 21st

39. Begins with light trades heading S.W. Middle part head showers of rain heading S.W. by S. latter part clear so ends.
Lat. 12. 50. S
Long. 28. 20. W

Monday, Sept. the 22nd

40. Begins with moderate trades heading S.W. Middle part strong breeze & equally took in top gallt. sail & double reefed the top main heading S.W. by S. latter part took in jib main sail & spanker.
