81. Begins with fresh breeze from the E. heading S. by E. with all Sloopers sail set. Middle part strong gales from the N. E. with hard squalls. took in the Jib & main sail & close reefed the top sail, at 10. took in the fore top sail at 2. took in the fore sail, heading S. by E. latter part cloudy & squally, reefed the fore sail & set. M. No 6h. Lat. by D R

Monday, Nov. the 3^d 1851

82. Begins with light breeze from the N. steering S. by E. with thunder, lightning & rain under short sail Middle part variable & squally set & close reefed top sail & lower, heading from S. by E. to S. by N. latter part strong gales from N. by W. steering S. by E. as ends

Tuesday, Nov. the 4th 1851

83. Begins with strong breeze from N. by W. steering S. by E. at 2. turned out the reef, More Moderate, set top gall sail & fore top Mast standing sail, at 4. equally took in top gall sail & standing sail, at 8. close reefed the top sail, heavy sea, latter part More Moderate turned out the reef, set top gall sail & top Mast standing sail, steering S. by E.

Wednesday, Nov. the 5th 1851

84. Begins with strong breeze from N. by W. steering S. by E. with all Sloopers sail set, at 2. took in fore top Mast standing sail fore top gall sail & double reefed the fore top sail steering S. by E. Middle part the same, latter part fresh gales from the N. & equally. took in the main top gall sail as ends

Thursday, Nov. the 6th 1851.

85. Begins with fresh gales from the N. & equally, steering S. by E. with all Sloopers sail set. Middle the same, latter part set the main top gall sail, saw Right Whale, so ends

Friday, Nov. the 7th 1851.

86. Begins with fresh gales from N. by W. steering S. by E. with all Sloopers sail set. Middle part More Moderate, made sail set standing sail, latter part light breeze from the N. & cloudy steering S. by E. One Ship in sight. No 6h. Lat. by D R

Saturday, Nov. the 8th 1851.

87. Begins with light breeze from the N. steering S. by E. with all sail set, cloudy weather, Middle part variable from N. by E. to S. latter part fresh breeze from N. by W. took in standing sail steering S. by E. One sail in sight. Lat. by 6h 39. 48. S

Long. by 6h 48. 00. W.

Variation, 29.° 30.° West.

Sunday, Nov. the 9th 1851

88. Begins with fresh breeze from N. by W. steering S. by E. at 8. strong breeze, took in top gall sail & double reefed the top sail, at 10. equally took in the jib & main sail, latter part squally & rainy, close reefed the top sail. No 6h by D R

Monday, Nov. the 10th 1851

89. Begins with strong breeze from the N. & rainy, steering S. by E. under short sail, at 1. the wind changed suddenly to the S. & Moderated, set double reefed top sail, jib & main sail, Middle & latter part light breeze from the N. set all sail, latter part steering S. by E. as ends

Lat. by 6h 40. 13. S

Long. by 6h 52. 15. W.
