Tuesday, Nov. the 11th /51

10. Begins with light breeze from the NW steering S by E with all sail set. Middle & latter part Moderate breeze saw black fish & fin backs, so ends. Lat. 40. 09. N Long. 56. 20. W

Variation, 22° 30' N.

Wednesday, Nov. the 12th /51

11. Begins with Moderate breeze from the NW steering S by E with all sail set. Middle & latter part variable from S by E to S by W took in studding sail heading to the eastward, fin backs plenty. Lat. 39. 33. N Long. 59. 30. W

Variation, 26° 30' N.

Thursday, Nov. the 13th /51

12. Begins with light breeze from the S by E heading S by E. Middle & latter part light breeze from the S by E & N. set studding sail, steering S by E saw many fin backs & Discolored water. Lat. 39. 09. N Long. 61. 18. W

Friday, Nov. the 14th /51

13. Begins with Moderate breeze from the NW steering S by E with all sail set. Middle & latter part fresh breeze from the NW, so ends. Lat. 39. 09. N Long. 65. 10. W

Saturday Nov. the 15th /51

14. Begins with strong breeze from the NW steering S by E with all sail set. at 10 equally from the W. with rain took in studding sail, top gallt sail main sail, & reefed the top sail. Middle & latter part strong gale from NW & equally, saw black fish at 9 set the main sail

Outward Bound, November 1851.

Variation, 20° West. Sunday, November the 16th /51

15. Begins with strong gale from NW steering S by E with all necessary sail set. Middle & latter part more moderate turned out the reefs, set top gallt sail & studding sail wind, N. & cloudy. No Obs. Lat. by Obs. 38. 25. N Long. by Obs. 74. 50. W

Monday, Nov. the 17th /51

16. Begins with strong breeze from the N. & cloudy, with showers of rain, steering S by E at 12, then took in the lower studding sail, at 6, squally & foggy, took in studding sail, top gallt sail & bulle reefed the top sail. Middle part the same, latter part more moderate wind S by W made all necessary sail, saw a Dutch Merchant vessel, so ends. Lat. by Obs. 38. 02. N Long. by Obs. 74. 40. W

One sail in sight.

Variation, 18° West. Tuesday, Nov. the 18th /51

17. Begins with strong breeze from the S by E steering S by E with all necessary sail set. Middle part light breeze from S by E steering S by E, latter part light breeze from the W steering S by E, so ends. Lat. by Obs. 37. 42. N Long. by Obs. 72. 00. W

North by current.

Saw the Land, Amsterdam

Wednesday, Nov. the 19th /51

18. Begins with Moderate breeze from the W steering S by E at 6, saw the Island of Amsterdam, took in sail. Middle part southerly, variable at day, run for the land at 10, sent two boats on a fishing party, saw the Ships America & Robert, Dufford, of New Bedford & Jefferson & Clements of New London. Lat. 38. 50. N Long. 77. 50. W

Variation 16° West

Thursday, Nov. the 20th /51

19. Begins with fresh breeze from the NW, laying off the land at 3, the boat returned with good success, light of S by E, Middle part the same, latter part cloudy, set studding sail steering S by E. No Obs. Lat. by Obs. 38. 00. N Long. by Obs. 81. 40. W
