Friday, November the 21st / 51

100. Begins with fresh breezes from N.W. & cloudy steering S.W. with all Keesey sail set. Middle & latter part. More moderate. saw hatter, Lat. 37. 57. S. Long. 83. 40. E

Latitude 15. West

Saturday Nov the 22nd / 51

101. Begins with Moderate breeze from N.W. steering S.W. with studding sail set. Cloudy weather, Middle & latter part strong breeze. the watch employed in cutting down & fitting it for a Wagon, as before. Lat. 38. 25. S. Long. 84. 20. E

Plenty of fin backs.

Sunday Nov the 23rd / 51

102. Begins with strong breeze from N.W. steering S.W. at 2 took in the studding sail, thick & rainy. at 6 took in the main top gallt. sail & reefed the fore top sail steering S.W. Middle part. the same. latter part light breeze & cloudy. set studding sail, saw fin backs, as before. Lat. 38. 13. S. Long. 90. 35. E

Monday Nov the 24th / 51

103. Begins with light breeze from the N. steering S.W. Cloudy weather, all Keesey sail set. Middle part the same, latter part, light breeze from S.W. heading S.W. at 6 took in the studding sail, the watch employed in landing the Wagon, & repairing the fore top gallt. sail. as before. Lat. 37. 54. S. Long. 92. 15. E

Tuesday Nov the 25th / 51

104. Begins with light breeze from the S.W. heading S.W. but the fore top gallt. sail. Middle part variable, latter part Moderate breeze from S.W. & foggy, heading S.W. & S. Lat. 37. 35. S. Long. 94. 35. E

Outward Bound November 1851

Wednesday, November the 26th / 51

105. Begins with Moderate breeze from S.W. & foggy, heading S.W. with all Keesey sail set. Middle part strong breeze from the S. & rising double reefed the top sail, steering S.W. latter part strong gale from the N.W. with rain took in the fore main sail & close reefed the top sail. No Cal. Lat. by D.R. 38. 00. S. Long by D. - 97. 00. E

Latitude 14. West

Thursday Nov the 27th / 51

106. Begins with strong gale from the N.W. & rising steering S.W. Under close reefed top sail & fore sail. Middle part Moderate & cloudy. Made sail. latter part light air & calm. is dark. Lat. 38. 10. S. Long. 98. 40. E

Friday Nov the 28th / 51

107. Begins with light breeze from the N.W. & foggy, heading S.W. Middle & latter part strong breeze from S.W. with fog & rain took in top gallt. sail & double reefed the top sail. at 11 took in the fore & main sail. No Cal. Lat. by D. 38. 00. S. Long by D. 00. E

Saturday Nov the 29th / 51

108. Begins with strong gale from S.W. with heavy rain heading S. at 1 took in the top sail & fore sail heading S. under a fore spruce & fore top. Went stay sail. at 4 more moderate. wind N.W. kept off S. at close reefed top sail & fore sail. Middle the same, latter part wind N. Made sail. unbent the studding sail & sent down the boom. Clear weather. Lat. 37. 31. S. Long 104. 00. E
